Coach Steele recently completed her second season at Randolph College and is a 4-year veteran of the college coaching ranks. In the 2009 season, Randolph had the most successful

year in program history, breaking numerous school records. The WildCats finished 19-13 in the regular season and made the conference tournament for the first time in school history. Steele mentored ODAC Rookie of the Year Teresa Dalton, as well as ODAC Player of the Year, First Team All Region, and All American selection Lindsay Cross. Steele also took home ODAC Coach of the Year honors for her efforts. Steele played collegiately at Longwood University in Farmville, VA where she was a two-time All American.
